

# Your Soul's Code – It's been there since birth

Whether you are an entrepreneur or a not yet entrepreneur, you should know that your business is a physical expression of you. Even if you have no aspiration to start a business, your soul code is at play at work. This exercise is based on Sacred Geometry an ancient concept applied not only to the design and construction of religious structures such as churches, temples, and mosques, but also to the study of nature and the mathematical principles at work within.

There are many layers to understanding how sacred geometry can be applied to understand your mission in your work. This exercise is one of the first steps we use at Beyond Blind Spots, to help empower you in your work or business. There are subsequent exercises, that illustrate how your birth name is a mathematical sequence that houses additional information about your personal mission, personality, motivations and challenges.

We will begin with your birthdate and then share the archetype or energetic model, that aligns with that number from 1-9. Numbers are not just for mathematics, they each have a specific vibration, an energy.

Each time you celebrate a birthday, you are reminded, on an energetic level, of the opportunity to express yourself and your mission. Think about how these attributes have appeared in your life in the past and how you can use them in your life now.



# Gaining Insight – Your Learning Path

Using your birth date, fill in the boxes below with the corresponding numbers.

Example: **Shonda Rhimes**, renowned television writer and producer (Scandal, Grey’s Anatomy) was born on **January 13, 1970** or **1 – 13 - 1970**

## The Learning Path

This is the sum of all numbers in your birthdate and represents what you are here to **learn and apply in your life**. In this example for Shonda Rhimes, we would add all of the digits in her birthdate to arrive at the sum of 22.

$$1 + (1 + 3) + (1 + 9 + 7 + 0) = 22$$

Continue to reduce the number until you reach a single digit.

$$22 \quad \rightarrow \quad 2+2 = 4$$

This Learning Path archetype is the Teacher.

# Interpretation

No number is better or worse than another. Each Learning Path number has strengths and challenges. This exercise is meant for insight and is not prescriptive. You can apply this insight to your work and life. Let it affirm your intention and actions.

1 – The **LEADER**. You are striving for greater independence. To stand strong, courageous, inventive. You may even want to be pioneering. You are choosing to develop your will and use it wisely. You have the ability to generate creative work in any situation. Caution: Be careful not to override or over shadow others.

2 – The **MEDIATOR**. You strive for cooperation, interdependence and diplomacy. You see both sides and are recognized for your patience but value decisive action. Caution: Be sure to define limits, boundaries and scope of responsibility. Otherwise you may find yourself overdoing and caught in the weeds.

3 – The **COMMUNICATOR**. You strive to use creativity and expression to uplift. Language is your gift and your power – written and, or spoken. You are driven to be creative in anything you do. You are dynamic and energetic. Caution: Be mindful to use words as a tool and not a weapon. Watch out for scattered behavior and a lack of follow-through.

4 – The **TEACHER**. You are calling in productivity, reliability and responsibility. Bringing loyalty, trustworthiness and a results orientation is present in anything you do. For you, structure, step-by-step is key and “slow and steady wins the race”. You thrive when you know the rules. People look to you to help create order. Caution: Be conscious to maintain flexibility. Be aware of any tendency toward bossiness and bulldozing.

5 - The **FREEDOM SEEKER**. You strive for inner freedom through experience. You are a bringer of constructive change. Seeking understanding for self and others is crucially important to you.
